### **New Jersey Replicates MVP**

New Jersey takes a page out of the CCAT playbook. Governor Phil Murphy announced the creation of a pilot program that will provide NJ manufacturers grants for the purchase of equipment they need to improve operations. It took about two weeks to assemble the application, recalls Tahjay Greene, a senior at Platt Technical High School in Milford. First he had to gather his high school transcripts, three teacher recommendations, attendance and community service records and various signatures from school administrators. Greene landed an internship building military helicopters at Lockheed Martin's Sikorsky Aircraft, in Stratford, where he and 44 fellow high school-aged students became the newest members of the Teamsters Local 1150 this summer. They work full-time for eight weeks during the summers after their junior and senior years, and upon graduation, many receive full-time job offers at the helicopter manufacturer, making \$27 to \$29 an hour to start.
